

## Ten Eight Service Dogs Inc. 501(c)3

**Who** is eligible: Our clients have a medically substantiated disability and are in need of a service dog to alleviate the symptoms of their disability.

**What** can our dogs do: Service dogs are trained specific tasks that assist their person, therefore, each dog is unique. Here are some of the things service dogs can assist with: alerting to a medical event; retrieving items (such as dropped items and/or medication); mobility assistance such as counterbalancing; providing deep pressure therapy; opening doors, and more.

**When:** We are currently taking applications until January 30th and will be holding interviews at the end of February with an anticipated start date <u>for two teams</u> at the beginning of April. Our goal is to start 6 total teams in 2023.

**Where**: Most of the initial training will be done at the client's home and/or out in public. Foundational training is comprised of teaching good manners and exposing service dogs in training to many different environments.

**Why:** A service dog can provide an invaluable service to people who have physical, mental or emotional disabilities. At Ten Eight Service Dogs, Inc our mission is to subsidize the cost to make these services more attainable to a wider pool of people.
